1. President's Report – Gregg Dudzinski

- Planned summer construction for south wing could not be completed due to late/incomplete estimate by contractor. Will re-evaluate and plan for summer '24 completion. AC's are most pressing issue. May need to spend money to keep them going until we replace them with split units. Will accomplish general maintenance, repairs and kitchen counter-tops during Brother's Work Week in August (8/7-8/11).
- CHI Annual Inspection report deficiencies will be addressed.
- Need to keep momentum going. Start working on 55th B-day plans.
- Will be attending Grand Chapter on Thursday.
- 2. Vice President Report Mark O'Neill
 - Duties performed.
- 3. Treasurer Report Kyle Stuhlweissenburg
 - Account balance update (see attached).
 - Summer occupancy. Rooms 1-4 left vacant for planned construction.
 - By-law change needed regarding minimum funding (\$25K). Need an alternative interest-bearing account. President Dudzinski cannot make specific recommendations but said a dollar guaranteed money market account that yields 4-5% would be easy to set up. Brother Schooley already has the ability.
- 4. Secretary Report Dave Marino
 - Review meeting agenda.
 - Review of CHI inspection report. President Dudzinski said he would contact the contractor who replaced the stucco to get a quote for the retaining wall. Stated

the CHI inspector said our House was in great shape and head and shoulders above the other houses that he inspects.

- 5. Undergraduate Report- Consul Michael Esposito
 - Introduced himself to HC and brothers in attendance.
 - Requested that since rooms 1-4 are vacant if we could paint/clean carpets etc.
- 6. Alumni Report ERAU Relations Committee Chair Bill Kingsley
 - Fred J Ford Scholarship up and running. Still needs to be funded. Has pledged \$10K a year for five years. Min balance needs to be \$50K and then ERAU will pay out 5% in perpetuity. Scholarship only available for HI EX undergrad who is an active member in good standing. Many companies will match donations to educational institutions.
 - ERAU doing great. Largest incoming freshman class in history. Prescott growing by leaps and bounds.
 - Spoke about Fundraiser opportunity. Copper Bottom Distillery. Sourced bourbon.
 300-320 bottles at \$100 per private label barrel. 55th Thursday night party can be held on premise. Hoping to make approximately \$20K in profits for the House.
- 7. New Business
 - Copper Bottom Distillery Fundraiser. Spend \$12K to establish. Motion by Vice President O'Neill. Seconded by Trustee Fraser. Passes. Unanimous.


