- 1. Meeting rules review President Gregg Dudzinski
 - Review of mission statement.
 - Review of 2022 HC vision statement.
- 2. Approval of old minutes:
 - 2022 2nd quarter meeting regular meeting minutes.
 - Motion by Marino, 2nd by Pacheco, unanimous approval.
- 3. Old business
 - Waiting on remaining bricks. Looking to start construction of honor wall in early spring. Motion by O'Neill, seconded by Marino for a hard stop on brick orders by 10/31. Pacheco opposes. Passed.
- 4. President's Report Gregg Dudzinski
 - Went down to house in August and met with ERAU officials and new Grand Praetor.
 - Chapter will be forming an anti-hazing coalition (greeks, athletes and ROTC).
 Undergrad Hayden Ritchhart is the new consul, Davyd Yalansky is the new House Manager.
 - Two pool issues repaired this summer. Pool is operational. Handrail needs to be replaced.
 - Consul Ritchhart described undergrad house hurricane preparation. Filled sandbags, placed at pump room, laundry room and other vulnerable spots.
 Moved bench to protect sliding door. Siphoned the pool, taped windows, moved

- patio furniture into pool and chapter room. Went over evacuation routes with brothers residing/staying at the house.
- Gregg provided other hurricane preparation advice. Said DAB Commissioner
 May requested help cleaning up the community after the storm.
- His (Dudzinski) company provides matching donations. Will set up a scholarship through ERAU. We need more leverage to get sophomores into the house.
- 5. Vice President Report Mark O'Neill
 - Thanked Trustee Massey and brother Hammond for all their work on construction committee and drafting RFP.
 - Thanked brother Kingsley for help with RMF and by-laws.
- 6. Treasurer Report Kyle Stuhlweissenburg
 - Account balance update
 - All rooms, except one, are currently occupied.
 - Fire panel replacement, Blue Works pipe inspection and RMF bill were the big items this quarter. 5% discount for paying RMF bill early.
 - Motion to formally accept Treasurer Report by Marino, 2nd by Pacheco. Unanimous.
 - President Dudzinski further clarified account balances. Promissory note is a five year note that can only be earmarked and used for construction. Between rental income, 1855 Club donations and promissory notes we will be able to complete remodels on the north and south wings on schedule. Promissory notes are scheduled to be repaid before due date. Capital savings has a required \$20,000 reserve (by-laws) should be modified. Business accounts look great in October but then get drawn down throughout the semester.
 - Trustee Pacheco pointed out we collect approximately \$4500 a month from 1855
 Club. Capital savings account also has a \$15,000 min balance for room deposits.
 - President Dudzinski wanted to make sure Treasurer Stuhlweissenburg knew how much he was appreciated.
- 7. Secretary Report Dave Marino
 - All present duties performed.
- 8. Security Committee Report Brothers Banta and Marino
 - Brother Banta detailed the current state of the house security system (cameras) and the need to update/upgrade. Discussed the detailed proposal that he graciously and expertly put together. Brother O'Neill mentioned Cisco system that Brother Harrison would help with. Brothers Banta and Dudzinski both said licensing costs were too expensive. President Dudzinski tasked Brother Marino to put together an official proposal. He also stated the need for a breathable security closet door and access control protocols.
- 9. Undergraduate Report- Consul Hayden Ritchhart and House Manager Davyd Yalansky
 - Introduced themselves. Reported upstairs fire alarm pull switch needs to be replaced. Undergrads installed "Ring" doorbell cameras for seniors in the community with Commissioner May.

 President Dudzinski thanked them for stepping up and wants to rebrand alumni work week to "Eta Iota Chapter House Work Week". Cannot remodel the kitchen due to updated city ordinances, can only repair.

10. New Business

- Trustee Massey and Brother Hammond discussed RFP for wing remodels.
 President Dudzinski said it will be a fixed price contract. No more cost plus.
 Requested final RFP to be ready by 10/17. Motioned by Pacheco. 2nd by Marino.
 Unanimous.
- Kitchen repairs to be performed during summer work week. Motioned by O'Neill.
 2nd by Marino. Unanimous.
- President Dudzinski stressed the importance of Work Week. Wants Trustee
 Hesterberg to socialize the week, bbq, golf, fraternity, etc. Trustee Massey is
 planning for last half of August, after summer B graduation. Motion by O'Neill, 2nd
 by Bonini. Unanimous.
- Discussed ERAUs restriction on sophomores living off campus. Pitch to ERAU that House Corp's mission is to provide lost cost housing to Univ students! Would like to set up a meeting with Univ officials and Brothers Kingsley & Pacheco. It's an easy retention vs housing equation.
- Need to update House Corp by-laws. Brother Kingsley spoke highly of RMF policy and is onboard for by-law changes to run in parallel with RMF policy.
 Would like have by-law proposed changes by January so they can be voted upon at Annual meeting. Tasked Vice President O'Neil to work with Brother Kingsely and committee.
- Discussed House Corp Officer and Trustee succession planning.
- Discussed House Corp contingency planning for hypothetical chapter charter action.
- Asked Trustee Massey and Brother Cassino to work on IT plan (web site migration to cloud).
- Brother Williams complemented HC for all their work and transparency.
- Secretary Marino enters into record NYY RF Aaron Judge hits 61st homerun of the season, tying Roger Maris!

Motion to adjourn by Secretary Marino, 2nd by Vice President O'Neill, unanimous. Meeting adjourned 1824 EDT.


